## ■ INTRODUCTION

This training course aims to provide European policy makers with a comprehensive analysis of the functioning and regulation of the EU ETS and of its interaction with other European policies.

The programme of the course is structured into eight lectures: four of them focus on the topic areas covered in the LIFE SIDE report “A literature-based assessment of the EU ETS”, which is a central deliverable of the project. The four areas are: Free allowance allocation, competitiveness effects and carbon leakage, Interactions with other policies, Low-carbon innovation and investment and The international dimension. Four more lectures will complement the course, providing a thorough presentation of the EU climate policy and of the EU ETS post-2020, and dealing with the key topics of “The role of bank and other financial actors” and of “Price drivers, market power and behavior”. Each lecture will include a Q&A session to enable participants to actively engage with the instructors and assimilate the content of the course in an effective way.
