■ INTRODUCTION

This is the final conference of the LIFE SIDE project. The event will provide the opportunity to present the conclusions of a literature-based report assessing the performance of the EU ETS and to discuss some of the most important issues of the EU ETS post-2020. The conference will gather an audience of high-level policy makers and stakeholders, including representatives from European institutions, the industrial sector, NGOs and academia.
